### PROJECT SEVEN Modular System

#### Assignment Overview

The modular system is dependent on standardized nonobjective elements or units that act as a ground to hold and contain text. Examples of the modular system include building blocks, storage containers, ad component systems. Modules can be as simple as a hairline square or rectangle or more complex geometric shapes such as circles, ellipses, etc. The idea is to standardize the unit on which the typography rests and then compose the message with the modules.

#### Deliverables

You will create an 10" x 16" poster for Bumbershoot, Seattle's Music & Arts Festival, using the Modular System as the structure for your composition.

#### Process

**Reading Assignment:** Elam pages 121–137.

**Part One: Sketches** Bring at least 20 sketches to show in class.

**Part Two: Computer Comps** Bring at least 3 comps to class, printed out in color at full scale.

**Part Three: Final version** Final print-out of your digital work.

Composition can use tones and transparency.

Composition can use one sans serif font.

Composition can use various type sizes and weights.

Compositions can incorporate illustration and/or photography (original images only).
